


What your child will be learning this term.

English
Our texts for this term are How to Live Forever and Our Tower.
Whilst focusing on 'How to Live Forever' the children will be practicing how to write dialogue between characters, instructions and letters.
When reading 'Our Tower', we will be writing fantasy narratives, poems and diary entries. This allows the children to develop their skills for writing different genres of writing whilst using similar skills for more than one style.

Maths:
During this term the children will be focusing on measure, time, money, shapes and position. Throughout these topics they will develop their knowledge and skills whilst also transferring previously taught skills such as addition, subtraction, multiplication, division and problem solving to achieve the skills for their year group.

History
In the second half of the term our topic will be all about the settlement of the Anglo Saxons and the Scots. Thinking about where they travelled from, asking questions as to why they travelled and settled where they did. We will also be looking at what life was like for them when they settled in Britain.

Science
In Science we are learning all about  and the best environments for them to survive in. They will also be learning about Rocks and their properties and how they are formed. The children will then be able to group rock types to demonstrate their understanding.

Design Technology
Our DT topic will support our history topic and we will look at the foods that were available to the Anglo Saxons and look at what foods would be put together to create a meal.

Computing

This term's Geography is all about Land use. This will entail carrying out field work to investigate how the local land is used and how this supports the local community.
