This week Amazon Class have continued their learning with enthusiasm.

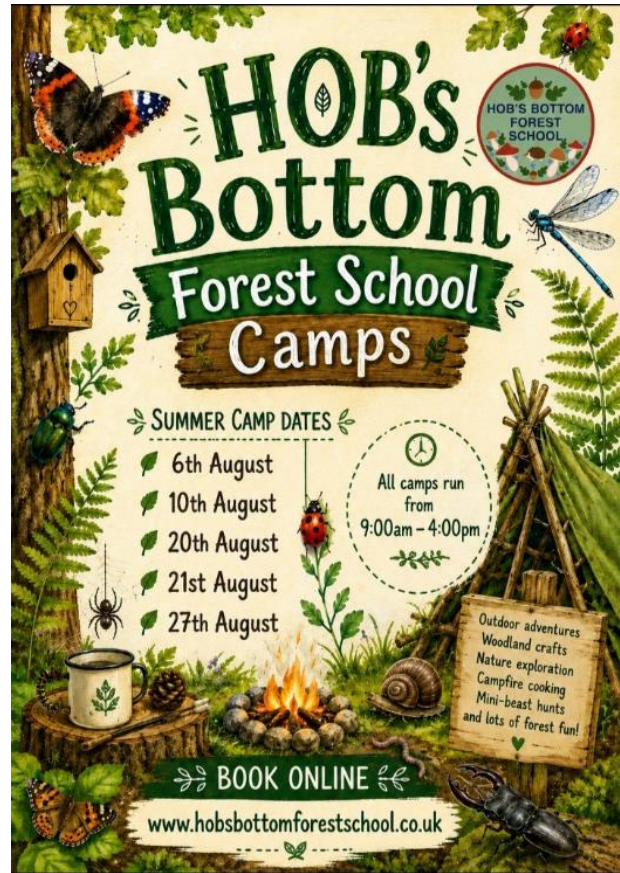
They continue to practice using onomatopoeia in their work this week and have been thinking about the effect this has on their writing.
